



The general login section is located on the top right header.



Once users have successfully logged in and set up their profile, the personalized dashboard will give an overview of the coworking space, workgroups, latest comments and news.





View of the personal dashboard

Write / edit (own created groups/group admin, group content where participants, own created activities)

Delete (only own user account, own activities, own groups)

*Registered user with extended rights: You can be made manager of a network by admin (CWSS) or your regional focal point. As such, you can invite new persons into that particular network.
